ORTP 2035 Vision and Goals

Vision and Goal statements are an important first step in developing the ORTP, as their attainment provides the framework against which potential transportation solutions will be measured.

Vision

In 2035, Oahu will be a place where we will have efficient, well-maintained, safe, secure, convenient, appropriate, and economical choices in getting from place to place. Our transportation system will move us and the goods we use in a manner that supports the island's high quality of life, natural beauty, economic vitality, and land use policies by supporting appropriate density development and avoiding urban sprawl. This system will promote energy conservation and economic sustainability as well as the protection of our ports of entry, preparation for emergency situations and changes in global climate.

Goals

I. Transportation Facilities

Provide an inclusive, multi-modal transport system whose connectedness provides efficient means for users desiring to move about this island by bicycle, freight carrier, pedestrian facility, road, transit service, and intermodal connectors.

II. Transportation Operations & Services

Develop, operate, and maintain Oahu's island-wide transportation system to ensure the efficient, dependable, safe, secure, convenient, and economical movement of people and goods.

III. Natural Environment

Develop, operate, and maintain Oahu's transportation system in a manner that sustains environmental quality.

IV. Human Environment and Quality of Life

Develop, operate, and maintain Oahu's transportation system in a manner that supports community-wide values related to health, safety, and civil rights.

V. Land Use and Transportation Integration

Develop, operate, and maintain Oahu's transportation system in a manner that integrates effective land use and transportation with established sources of funding in a fair and equitable manner.
