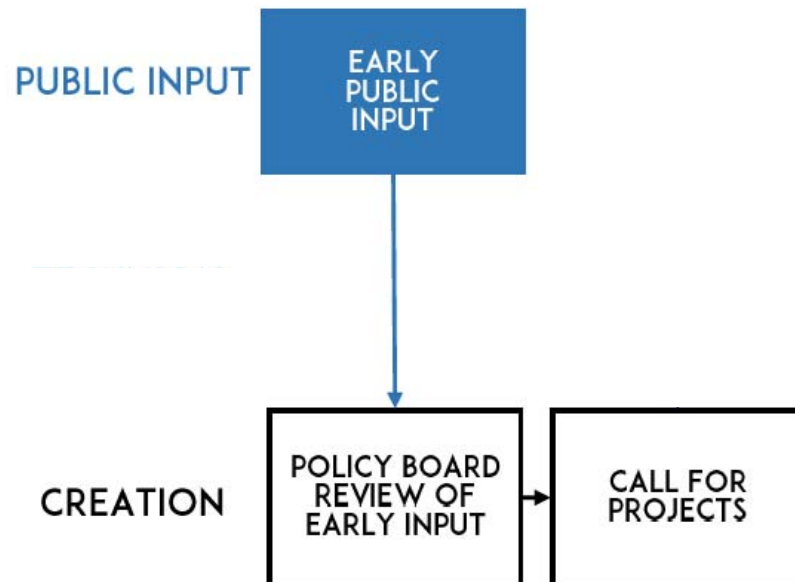




What is the TIP?

- **A programming document produced by OahuMPO:**
 - for all federally-funded surface transportation projects
 - ‘Regional’ significance (Oahu only)
 - Some examples?
- **Current document: 2015-2018**
 - 4 years only
 - Approved by CAC and Policy Board in 2014
 - Subject to revision (17 revisions thus far)
- **Next TIP document: 2019-2022**
 - In development now
 - The Policy Board must approve the next document in summer 2018
 - Subject to future revision, once approved
