### Executive Director's Report

#### *Accomplishments and Progress*

1. As I had reported last month, we are currently conducting outreach events for the Oahu Regional Transportation Plan's (ORTP) first phase of public involvement. At these events, we are asking the public for their transportation goals and priorities for the future. To date, we have attended **eight community events**, and engaged **797 people**. #### *Policy Board (PB)*

The PB met on January 29, 2019 and received an informational summary of the 2018 OahuMPO Transportation Management Area Planning Certification Review Summary Report.

#### *Citizen Advisory Committee (CAC)*

The CAC met on January 16, 2019, and elected a new Chair, Joseph Magaldi, and Vice Chair, Dick Poirier. The Oahu MPO presented to the CAC a Year-in-Review Report of their accomplishments, performance, and recommended areas of improvement. The 2019 OahuMPO agenda for public involvement was outlined and will include long-term regional planning, transportation investment programming, annual overall work program planning, public participation planning, and individual studies to coordinate a more effective public participation in 2019.
