Accomplishments and Progress

1. As I had reported last month, we are currently conducting outreach events for the Oahu Regional Transportation Plan's (ORTP) first phase of public involvement. We are asking the public for their transportation goals and priorities for the future. At this time, we have attended **35 community events**, and engaged over **2,400 people**. Citizen Advisory Committee (CAC)

The CAC met on March 20, 2019, and Council Member Heidi Tsuneyoshi made an informal presentation on elements of a Council Resolution as it relates to the CAC's proposed North Shore Corridor Study. Oahu MPO gave an update on the OWP FY2020 status and an update on Oahu Regional Transportation Plan 2045 Phase 1 which covered public involvement around vision and goals. DTS gave an informational presentation on the City's Transportation Demand Management Initiative, highlighting how it may address some of the work elements that CAC had proposed for the OWP FY2020.
