### Executive Director's Report

#### *Accomplishments and Progress*

As I reported last month, we are currently conducting public outreach for the Oahu Regional Transportation Plan's (ORTP) first phase of public involvement. We are asking the public for their transportation goals and priorities through 2045. At this time, we have attended 37 community events, and engaged over 2,400 people. We plan to attend several community events through May. #### *Technical Advisory Committee (TAC)*

The TAC met on April 12, 2019 and received an informational briefing on the Certification Review Implementation Plan which outlined the OahuMPO schedule to implement recommendations from the 2018 Certification Review.

Also an informational briefing was provided to update the changes made to the schedule and the total funding request for the Overall Work Program (OWP) FY 2020.
