Executive Director's Report

Accomplishments and Progress

1. We are in the process of completing our first phase of public involvement for the Oahu Regional Transportation Plan (ORTP), where we asked the public for their transportation goals and priorities for the future. We attended **43 community events** and engaged **3,063 people**.

We are currently conducting focus groups in each of the planning areas, to gain a more in-depth understanding of the public's transportation needs and concerns, and how they envision getting around in the future.

2. Ray Tellis, FTA IX Regional Administrator met with Oahu MPO on May 3, 2019 to discuss the update of the Certification Review milestone and progress.
3. The OWP FY2020 has been released for public and intergovernmental review and will close on May 17, 2019.

Policy Board (PB)

The Policy Board met on April 30, 2019 and received from the WSP Modeling Consultants an update on the Travel Demand Forecasting Model. HART provided a presentation on the Transportation Transit Fares Scenario Modeling Study which the Board approved as evidence that the work was carried out and directed the staff to use the study recommendations in the Oahu MPO's planning process.

Technical Advisory Committee (TAC)

The TAC met on May 10, 2019 and received an informational briefing by Dr. Charles (Chip) Fletcher, Professor of Geology and Geophysics at the UH School of Ocean and Earth Science and Technology on the Sea Level Rise Modeling in which he shared the latest on sea level rise modeling and the likely nature and areas of impact on Oahu.
