Executive Director's Report

Accomplishments and Progress

- The Federal Highway Administration and the Federal Transit Administration jointly approved the FY2020 Overall Work Program (OWP) in a letter dated July 9, 2019. Staff's efforts to develop, reorganize, and review the OWP were commended.
- OahuMPO has hired a summer intern, Logan Takeda. Logan currently attends University of Portland, where he studies civil engineering. After he graduates, he wants to move back to O'ahu and work as a transportation engineer, with the goal of decreasing vehicle crashes and reducing congestion on O'ahu.
- OahuMPO is currently in the final phases of recruitment of a Transportation Impact Analyst. We hope to complete the process and fill the position by the end of summer. This person's responsibilities will include the management of the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP).

Policy Board (PB)

The Policy Board (PB) met on June 25, 2019, received a briefing on the final draft of the FY2020 Overall Work Program (OWP) which identified planning studies, projects, and other work elements that the OahuMPO staff and agency partners will be working on in the coming fiscal year. The PB discussed and endorsed the final draft of the FY2020 OWP for submission to the Federal Highway Administration and the Federal Transit Administration for approval.

Citizen Advisory Committee (CAC)

The CAC met on June 19, 2019, and the City Office of Climate Change, Sustainability and Resiliency (OCCSR) provided an informational briefing on the OCCSR's climate action planning and resilience strategy, focusing on the City's long-term carbon mitigation strategies for buildings and transportation.
