Policy Board (PB)

The Policy Board met on July 30, 2019, received a briefing on the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) 2019-2022 Revision #5 (Administrative Modification) and #6 (Amendment). They approved both revisions as presented.

The Policy Board Chair provided a report on his experience at the 2019 53rd Annual National Association of Regional Councils (NARC) Conference held June 9-12, 2019 at Omaha, Nebraska. NARC supports the upcoming Congressional transportation reauthorization to provide adequate, stable, and flexible funding; enhances the role of MPO's to achieve increased mobility, access to opportunities, and economic prosperity; prioritizes transportation safety to eliminate deaths and serious injuries; and empowers regions to meet the challenges and opportunities created by technology and data.
