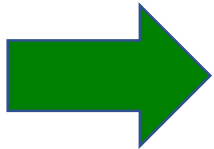

About the Overall Work Program

- It describes and programs **planning studies** (along with any defined objectives, tasks, and deliverables) undertaken by OahuMPO and its participating agencies
- It describes and programs the **budgetary and staffing requirements** for OahuMPO
- It is a requirement for **metropolitan transportation planning** performed with Federal funds



OWP Planning Priorities

1. Federally Required
2. Necessary to support transportation planning process or other Fed, State, or City Requirements.
3. Support projects identified in ORTP.
4. Support master plans or other OahuMPO, state, or city, planning documents
5. Support Oahu's integrated, multimodal transportation system.

Island Wide Traffic Signal Timing Evaluation	Ineligible – focuses on operations Also addressed by the following: OC04 DTS Optimizes Signal Timing OC10 DTS Adaptive Traffic Control
