### Executive Director's Report

#### *Accomplishments and Progress*

Recruitments for our Senior Transportation Planner and Intern positions continues. We ask you to encourage anyone who may be interested to apply. More information about these recruitments can be found at: <https://www.oahumpo.org/about-mpo/job-opportunities/>

Randolph Sykes rejoined OahuMPO on September 23, 2019 and will be working on special projects such as the 5-year Strategic Plan mandated in the 2014 & 2018 Certification Reviews, the Financial & Administrative Supplemental Agreements which expire at the end of FY2021, and assisting with the Senior Transportation Planner recruitment.

The Central Oahu Transportation Study is nearing completion. The Central O'ahu Transportation Study Draft Report was available for public and inter-government comment through October 7, 2019. A recap of the comments received and the closing presentation will be included on the TAC's November meeting agenda.

OahuMPO is gearing up for the Call-for-Projects to all agencies for the FY2021 Overall Work Program (OWP) which is scheduled to occur before the end of October and agencies will have an opportunity to submit their candidate projects by the end of November.

#### *Policy Board (PB)*

The Policy Board met on September 24, 2019 and received a briefing on the draft policy of Vision Zero which aims to eliminate traffic fatalities. They also heard the closing presentations for the Oahu Coastal Communities Evacuation Planning Project-Phase 2 and the Oahu Bike Plan Update, and approved the 2019 OahuMPO Title VI/Environmental Justice Program Implementation Draft Plan which was updated in accordance with requirements of the FTA, FHWA, and HDOT Civil Rights Office.

#### *Citizen Advisory Committee (CAC)*

The CAC met on September 18, 2019, and received the Vision Zero Policy, Oahu Coastal Communities Evacuation Planning Project-Phase 2, and the Oahu Bike Plan Update presentations.
