Executive Director's Report

Accomplishments and Progress

Welcome Zakari Mumuni who joined the OahuMPO Team on February 3, 2020 as the Senior Transportation Planner. He has a wealth of transportation planning experience and recently arrived from St. Louis, Missouri.

OahuMPO staff facilitated several meetings with our partner agencies in the past weeks to discuss transit modeling updates to the travel demand forecasting model.

Technical Advisory Committee (TAC)

The TAC met on February 14, 2020, and received from OahuMPO a presentation on the Overall Work Program FY2021 Public Review Draft and the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) FFY2019-2022 Revision #10 which the TAC recommended the Policy Board approval as presented.

Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC)

The CAC met on February 19, 2020 and received a presentation of the Overall Work Program FY2021 which will be sent out for Public and Intergovernmental Review in early March, a presentation on TIP Revision #10, and a brief overview of the OWP PM Peak Tow Away Zone Time Modifications on Urban Arterials Study which will be presented by DTS in a future meeting. Researchers from the University of Hawaii Department of Urban and Regional Planning who are conducting research on transportation vulnerability and adaptation to sea level rise attended the CAC meeting and indicated they are looking for volunteers to participate in interviews. The CAC was also advised that the OahuMPO Public Participation Plan is out for Public and Intergovernmental Review and encouraged to submit comments.
