Executive Director's Report

Accomplishments and Progress

OahuMPO received a letter dated June 26, 2020 from The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) notifying OahuMPO of their approved of the FY2021 Overall Work Program (OWP). The cumulation of the OahuMPO staff's efforts to develop, reorganize, and review the OWP is commendable.

The Overall Work Program (OWP) FY2020 Revision #3 Draft was posted to the OahuMPO website on June 12, 2020. Revision #3 is an Administrative modification that moves \$24,000 in funds between approved work elements that support OahuMPO staff time. It can be viewed at https://www.oahumpo.org/?wpfb_dl=1905.

OahuMPO staff collected feedback on the prioritization process for the Oahu Regional Transportation Plan (ORTP) 2045 from the ORTP technical working group and followed up with agencies to discuss comments. This process will be used to prioritize projects and programs submitted to the MPO for consideration for funding. OahuMPO staff are tentatively scheduled to bring a revised prioritization process to the advisory committees and the Policy Board in July 2020.

Technical Advisory Committee

The TAC met on June 12, 2020, discussed, and recommended to the Policy Board their approval of the Accelerated TIP Amendment Policy which will be presented to you today. The Congestion Pricing Study Tour Presentation was made by TAC Member, Marian Yasuda and Policy Board Vice Chair, Brandon Elefante of their 2019 tour to London and Stockholm. Seven other cities had representatives at this event. OahuMPO anticipates that a proposed amendment to the OWP FY21 will be presented to the OahuMPO advisory committees and Policy Board in the fall and will include a congestion pricing study. The Department of Planning and Permitting (DPP) is currently working with OahuMPO on the development of the study proposal which is based on a proposal submitted by the Citizen Advisory Committee.

Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC)

The CAC did not meet on June 3, 2020. Their July 1, 2020 meeting has been cancelled. Their next meeting is scheduled on August 5, 2020.
