### Executive Director's Report

#### *Accomplishments and Progress*

The OahuMPO staff attended the bi-annual Sub-Statewide Transportation Advisory Committee (Sub-STAC) meetings on October 21-22, 2020. The Sub-STAC working group consists of members from HDOT, DTS, FHWA, OahuMPO, Maui MPO and other agencies working cooperatively with the focus of improving transportation outcomes and policy. Topics at this meeting included public outreach during COVID-19, equity issues, the Hawaii Statewide Transportation Plan, emerging trends for clear transportation. OahuMPO staff participated on a virtual public involvement panel, where panelists shared experiences and lessons learned.

OahuMPO staff held an O'ahu Regional Transportation Plan (ORTP) 2045 working group meeting on Friday, October 23rd. During the meeting, staff provided an overview of the project and program applications received for consideration of Federal transportation funding, and their evaluation and scoring. OahuMPO staff will present the project and program submissions, their evaluation, and scoring at today's meeting.

OahuMPO hosted two virtual open houses on Thursday, November 12th from 11:30AM-1:00PM and 6:00PM-7:30PM. The virtual open houses served as an opportunity for the public to get to know OahuMPO, what we do, and how they can get involved in our planning efforts. We're hosting one more virtual open house on Saturday, November 21st - 10:30AM-12:00PM.

#### *Policy Board (PB)*

The Policy Board met on October 27, 2020 and voted to adopt the DTS Transit Safety Targets and incorporate those targets into OahuMPO work products. The OahuMPO staff discussed

and provided an update on the progress made on the 2018 Federal Certification Review Implementation Plan. The OahuMPO staff also presented an evaluation of Phase 1 public participation efforts of the Oahu Regional Transportation Plan 2045.

#### *Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC)*

The CAC met on November 4, 2020, and staff presented the Overall Work Program FY2021 Revision #1 that proposes adding the Work Where You Live study and the Congestion & Mobility Pricing Study; Oahu Regional Transportation Plan 2045 Project and Program Submissions, Evaluation, and Scoring; and the Phase 2 Public Involvement Plan.
