ORTP 2045 UPDATES

Transportation Revenue Forecast

OahuMPO and its consultant, Jacobs have finalized OahuMPO's Transportation Revenue Forecast, which forecasts the amount of money, that Oahu can reasonably expect to be available to spend on transportation projects and programs through 2045. This forecast is important because it helps to guide which projects and programs are selected for funding. In compliance with federal law, the costs of projects and programs selected for funding must be within the forecasted revenue amount.

Comments Received on Draft 2045 ORTP Projects and Programs List

OahuMPO conducted the 2045 ORTP Proposed Projects and Programs survey between November 2020 to January 2021 to solicit feedback on the 17 newly proposed projects and programs. The survey received participation from 85 people, and the web map received 99 comments identifying locations for improvements for the proposed programs.

The final draft of the 2045 O'ahu Regional Transportation Plan is now out for public comment through **March 29, 2021**.

The preliminary list of projects and programs shared through this newsletter has not changed in the draft plan, as it was determined by the transportation revenue forecast that there is enough projected transportation funding to cover the expected costs of proposed projects and programs.

ORTP 2045 UPDATES

Upcoming Community Meetings: Let's talk about the ORTP 2045!

The Oahu Metropolitan Planning Organization (OahuMPO) coordinates the distribution of federal transportation funding for the island of Oahu. OahuMPO is currently working on the Oahu Regional Transportation Plan 2045 (ORTP 2045). The ORTP is a long-term document that outlines transportation goals, objectives, policies, and projects for Oahu's future. Projects and programs in the ORTP are eligible for federal transportation funding.

OahuMPO is coordinating virtual community meetings with transportation agency representatives and City Councilmembers to provide an opportunity for the community to provide feedback and ask questions regarding proposed projects in their communities. The following community meetings have been scheduled:

Central Oahu (District 8) | March 8, 2021 6:00pm

Central/West Oahu (District 9) | March 9, 2021 6:00pm

West Honolulu (District 7) | March 16, 2021 6:00pm

North Shore/Koolau Loa (District 2) | March 17, 2021 6:00pm

West Oahu (District 1) | March 22, 2021 6:00pm

East Honolulu (District 4 and 5) | March 24, 2021 6:00pm

Windward Oahu (District 3) | March 30, 2021 6:00pm

For the areas in which we are unable to schedule meetings due to elected city councilmember or agency sponsor time conflicts, OahuMPO staff will host an open house for community members of any district to ask questions and provide comments. The date of this open house will be: **March 18, 2021 at 6:00pm**

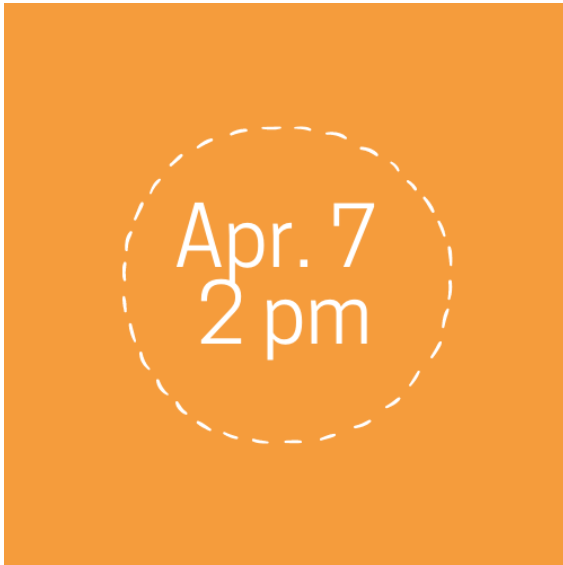

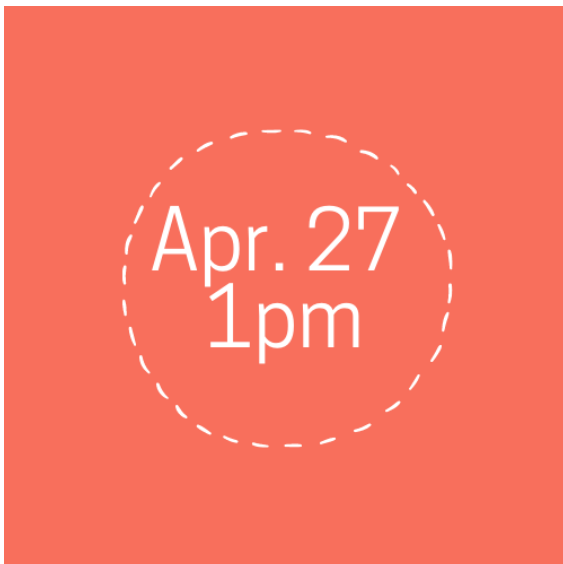
