Executive Director's Report

Accomplishments and Progress

OahuMPO staff worked in collaboration with the Hawaii Department of Transportation (HDOT), Department of Transportation Services (DTS), and Honolulu Authority for Rapid Transportation (HART) to complete a pre-approved modification of the FFYs 2019-2022 Transportation Improvement Program (Revision #21). Because this is a pre-approved modification, it does not require action from the Technical Advisory Committee or Policy Board, or public and intergovernmental review. OahuMPO participated in HDOT's speed management meeting on July 8, 2021. The purpose of this meeting was to help all agencies collectively plan on how to meet their safety performance targets. Discussion topics included safety countermeasures for Likelike Highway, potential coalition members, and next steps.

OahuMPO staff participated in HDOT's Sub-STAC meetings on July 21 and July 22. Discussion topics included the Hawaii Statewide Transportation Plan strategies and actions, the FFYs 2022-2025 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP), eSTIP, HDOT's Mid-Range Transportation Plan, Transportation Asset Management Plan 2022, climate change and transportation, and the Statewide Transportation Planning Organization.

Technical Advisory Committee (TAC)

The Technical Advisory Committee met on July 9, 2021 and received a presentation on the FFYs 2022-2025 Transportation Improvement Program. They voted to recommend Policy Board approval with some changes. In addition, the TAC members discussed providing the Policy Board annotations on TAC actions and requested annotations be include on a slide in the Policy Board PowerPoint presentation for each agenda item the TAC took action upon. Their next meeting is scheduled for August 13, 2021.

Citizen Advisory Committee (CAC)

The CAC met on July 7, 2021, and received a presentation on the FFYs 2022-2025 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and recommended Policy Board approval. Their next meeting is scheduled for August 4, 2021.
