Final Draft Plan Approved by the Policy Board

The final draft O'ahu Regional Transportation Plan (ORTP) was presented at the April 2021 Citizen Advisory Committee, Technical Advisory Committee, and Policy Board meetings. At their April 27, 2021, meeting, the OahuMPO Policy Board voted to approve the 2045 ORTP. The final plan can be viewed [here](#).

FY 2022 Overall Work Program

The Overall Work Program (OWP) is OahuMPO's annual budget. It describes and programs planning studies and budgetary and staffing requirements for OahuMPO. In the FY 2022 OWP, three new work elements are proposed for funding: data purchase to update the Travel Demand Forecasting Model, Active Transportation Monitoring Data Phase 2, and Active Transportation Monitoring Data Phase 3. The draft FY 2022 OWP was put out for public and intergovernmental review from March 17, 2021, through April 16, 2021. Comments and agencies responses may be viewed in Appendix C of the FY 2022 OWP. The final draft OWP will be presented at the May committee and Policy Board meetings.

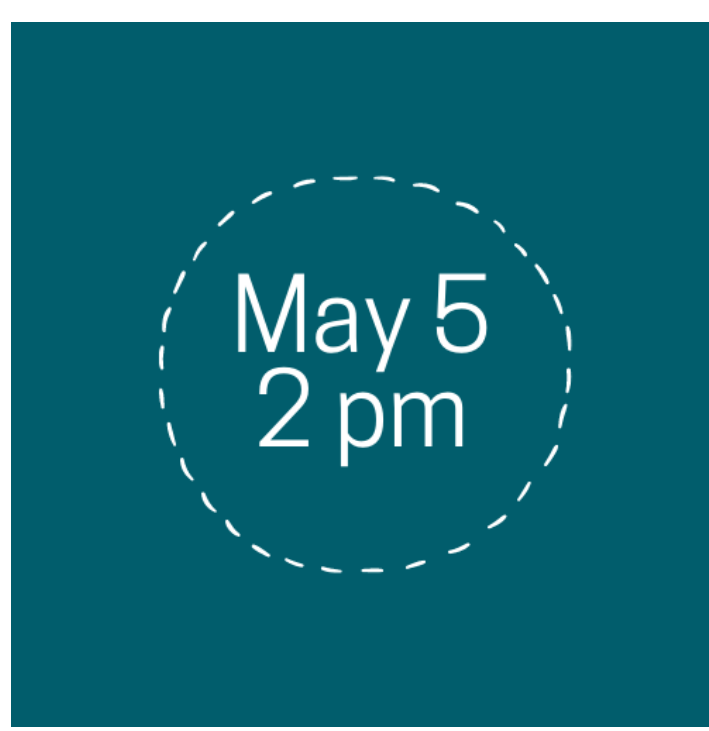


As you may have seen recently, Biki is at risk of shutting down. The COVID-19 pandemic has devastated businesses across Hawaii, and Biki has been severely impacted. While the City has been a great partner for Biki, the bikeshare system is not currently considered an official part of Honolulu's public transit system, and this essential service now faces potential closure if our leaders fail to act immediately.
