The OahuMPO's Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) is a four-year programming document that lists all near-term transportation projects on the Island of Oahu that are to receive federal funds or are regionally significant.

The Transportation Improvement Program FFYs 2022- 2025 was approved by the Policy Board on July 27, 2021. Materials from this meeting can be found [here](#).



The Overall Work Program (OWP) does two main things: 1) it describes and programs planning studies (along with any defined objectives, tasks, and deliverables), and 2) describes and programs the budgetary and staffing requirements for OahuMPO.

Revision #1 is an amendment to the FY 2022 OWP that proposes the deletion of the Mass Transit Joint Feasibility Study, the reduction of funds obligated for the Transportation Demand Management Plan, and the cancellation of three programmed subrecipient studies.

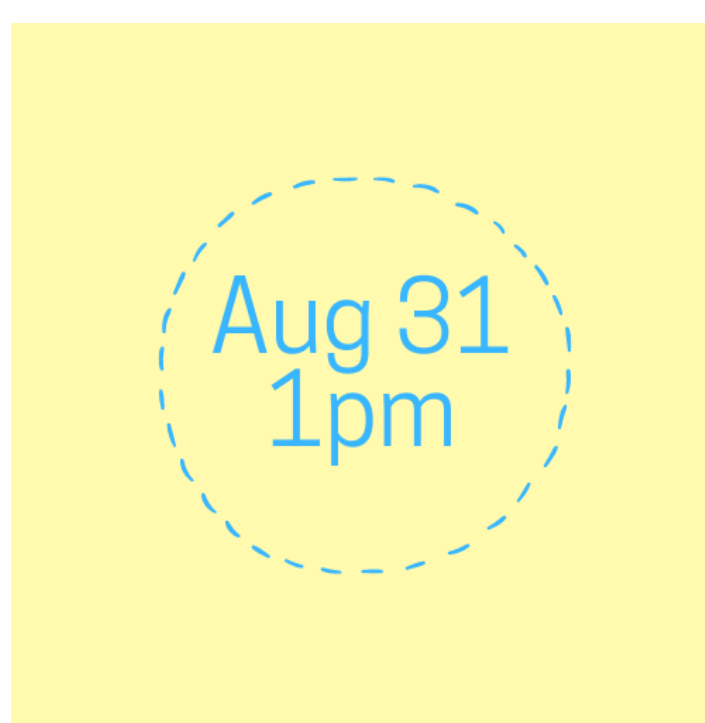
