##### **A. Executive Director**

Mark Garrity shared the following updates:

The Public Participation Plan has been out for public & intergovernmental review and comments are due today, January 14, 2022.

The new FFY 2022-2025 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), which includes the Oahu TIP, was approved by the Federal Highway Administration and the Federal Transit Administration effective November 23, 2021.

The draft TIP Revision #3 will be going out for public and intergovernmental review (IGR) during the week of January 10, 2022.

The Performance Improvement Plan Quarterly Check #2 is attached to the ED report and will be provided to the Policy Board at their January meeting.

The Policy Board met on November 30, 2021. The CAC met on January 14<sup>th</sup> and elected Chace Shigemasa as their Chair and Ken Farm as Vice Chair.

Chair Tatsuguchi asked about the timing for providing additional information on ORTP 2045 projects and Mr. Garrity said he would follow up.
