



Aloha from the OahuMPO staff!

- Full Closure of Eastbound H1 Freeway from Kinau Street to Piikoi Street Begins Nov. 7 (Posted 10/28/2022)
 - Roadwork will be scheduled on Monday nights through Friday mornings, from 8:30 p.m. to 4:30 a.m., beginning on Monday, Nov. 7.
 - Daytime roadwork will be scheduled on Election Day, Nov. 8, and on Veteran's Day, Friday Nov. 11, from 8:30 a.m. to 6 p.m.
 - The paving project is anticipated for completion by May 2023.
 - Detour: the Kinau Street offramp (Exit 22)

- Full Closure of the H3 Freeway Honolulu Bound for Tunnel Cleaning on Nov. 5 (Posted 10/28/2022)
 - Full closure of the H-3 Freeway in the Honolulu-bound direction at the Harano Tunnel from 7 p.m. on Saturday night, Nov. 5, through 7 a.m. on Sunday morning, Nov. 6, for tunnel maintenance.

- HDOT to Receive Climate Challenge Initiative Funding for Plastic Recycling Research (Posted 10/20/2022)
 - HDOT awarded \$312,000 in competitive grant funding
 - HDOT plans to combine this award with other funding sources to establish a plastic recycling research facility, the first of its kind in Hawai'i

- Full Closure of the H1 Freeway in Both Directions from the Waimalu Interchange to Waiawa Interchange for HECO Work (Posted 10/19/2022)
 - From Sunday, November 5 at 9:00 PM to 4:00 AM on Monday, November 6
 - Motorists are encouraged to use Kamehameha Hwy as detour

- H-1 Freeway Rehabilitation Project from Valkenburgh St to Salt Lake Blvd begins Oct. 21 (Posted 10/14/2022)
 - On Friday Nov. 18, and subsequent weekends, the H-1 Freeway Rehab project will require a full westbound closure. Closure details are as follows:
 - 2 westbound right lanes closed on Friday at 8 p.m.
 - 3 westbound right lanes closed on Saturday at 8:30 p.m.
 - Full westbound freeway closure on Sunday at 8 a.m.
 - All lanes will open on Monday at 2:30 a.m.
 - While the full closure is in place, motorists will be detoured to Kamehameha Highway as an alternate route

- HDOT Testing Asphalt Mixes Designed to Improve Pavement and the Environment (Posted 10/11/2022)
 - Fort Weaver Road between North Road and Cormorant Avenue will be paved during the pilot project.
 - The paving began on Oct. 11, 2022, and is expected to be complete in late July 2023, weather permitting.


Latest news:

- HART announced on 10/10/2022 that a Notice to proceed had been issued to Nan, Inc. for utilities infrastructure relocation along Dillingham Blvd.
- Physical construction is expected to begin before the end of 2022 and be completed by the first quarter of 2026

The Policy Board and the Technical Advisory Committee will hear a presentation on an update to the Overall Work Program Policies and Procedures.




