OAUMPO UPDATES

OahuMPO strives to provide updates to the community as needed. In terms of the long range plan, the **Oahu Regional Transportation Plan 2050**, a working group was established in February 2022 that is comprised of staff from the MPO, HDOT, DTS, HART, FHWA, and DPP. This working group will receive updates on the progress of the ORTP 2050 and provide suggestions and contributions along the way. The **Public Engagement Plan** for the ORTP 2050 has been drafted and will be presented to the committees this month (March). This document outlines the outreach strategies that will be employed in the development of the ORTP.

As for the **Transportation Improvement Plan** FFY 2022-2025, revisions #2 and #3 have been approved by the Policy Board on February 22, 2022. The revisions have now been sent to the Department of Transportation Director for approval.

Updates for the **Overall Work Program FY2022** include Revision #2 (amendment) which will be presented to the committees this month (March).

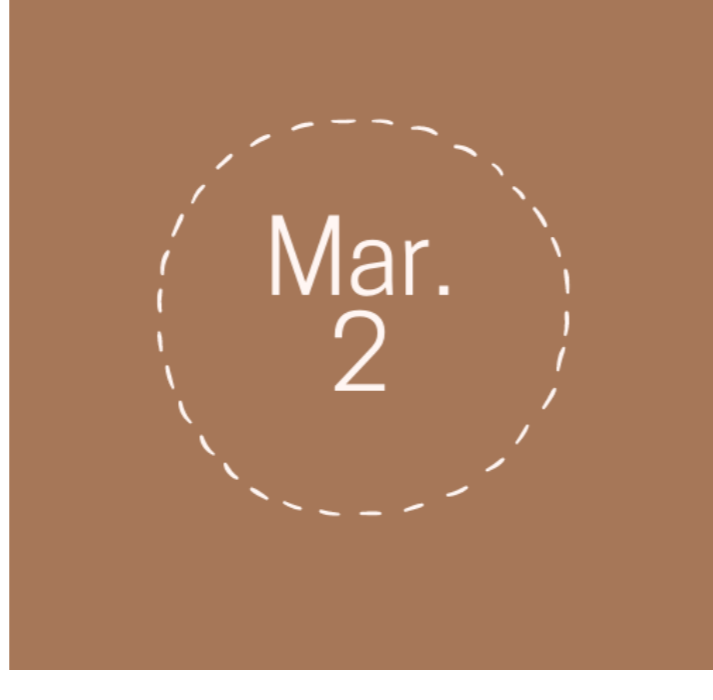

During the month of March, the MPO staff will be presenting the **Overall Work Program FFY2022 Revision #2**. Revision #2 is an amendment that adjusts the staff time budget to accommodate staffing changes, transfers balances from closed or expired consultant contracts to the travel demand forecasting model data purchase budget and deletes programmed studies as requested by the responsible agencies.

Staff will also be presenting the **Oahu Regional Transportation Plan 2050 Public Engagement Plan** to the committees. The Public Engagement Plan outlines outreach strategies to be employed in the development of the Oahu Regional Transportation Plan 2050. This plan aims to be comprehensive and flexible to consider the ongoing effects of the COVID-19 pandemic.

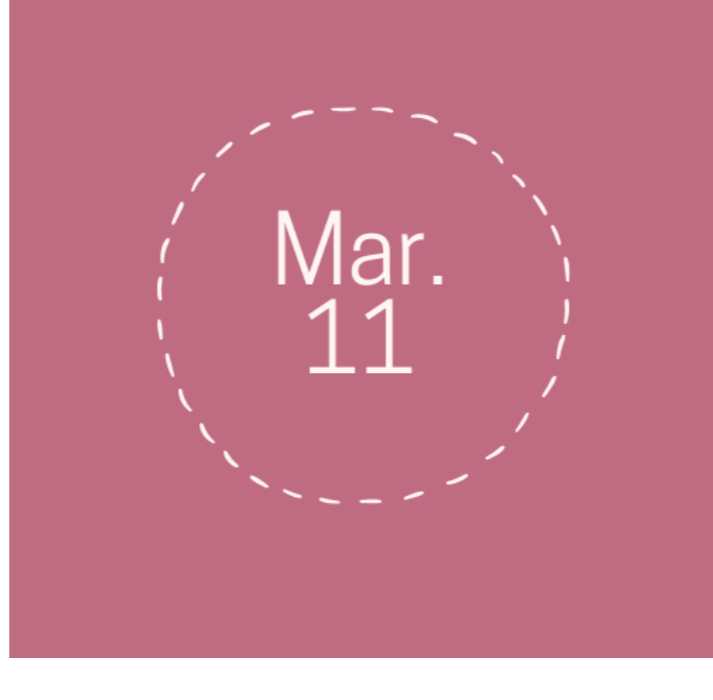
The final **Public Participation Plan** will be presented to the Policy Board for approval. Thank you to all who provided comments during the public and intergovernmental review period!

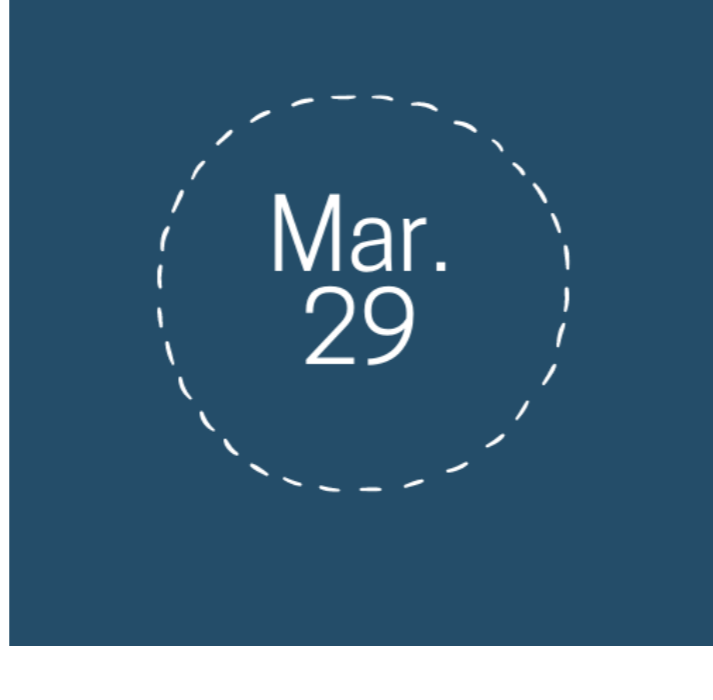
