A. **Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) FFYs 2022-2025 Revision 11**

The TIP is a short-term program that lists all surface transportation projects on the island of Oahu that are either regionally significant, uses federal transportation funding, or requires action by the federal transportation agencies. The TIP includes projects for roadways, bridges, transit, trails, bicycle facilities and sidewalks.

Revision 11 contains amendments involving major changes to 5 existing projects and considerations for 10 new projects.

Requested Action: *Recommend the Policy Board approve Revision 11 of the Transportation Improvement Program FFYs 2022-2025.*

B. **TMA Certification Review 2022**

Federal Law requires the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) to jointly certify the transportation planning processes of Transportation Management Areas (TMAs) at least every four years. FHWA & FTA performed the OahuMPO TMA Certification Review in summer of 2022 and jointly certified the OahuMPO in September 2022. FHWA Hawaii Division will present the findings from the 2022 TMA Certification Review Final Report.
