**A. TMA Certification Report**

Federal Law requires the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) to jointly certify the transportation planning processes of Transportation Management Areas (TMAs) at least every four years. FHWA and FTA performed the OahuMPO TMA Certification Review in summer of 2022 and certified the OahuMPO in September 2022.

**V. New Business**

**A. Overall Work Program FY2024-2025 Final Draft**

The Overall Work Program (OWP) is a requirement for metropolitan planning activities performed with Federal funds. The OWP provides information to Federal, State, and City officials and to the public regarding the planning activities being carried out by the OahuMPO and its partner agencies. In response to the 2022 TMA Certification Review, this OWP includes funding for a two-year period. OahuMPO staff will present the final draft of the Overall Work Program for FY 2024-2025 for review and action by the Citizens Advisory Committee.

**B. Oahu Regional Transportation Plan 2050 Update**

The O’ahu Regional Transportation Plan (ORTP) is a long-term document, with a 25-year time horizon, that outlines transportation goals, objectives, policies, and projects for O’ahu. Projects that are in the ORTP are eligible for Federal transportation funding. The ORTP is updated every five years and is currently under revision for 2050. The OahuMPO consultant team for the ORTP update seeks input from the Citizen Advisory Committee on the vision and goals statements for the

Plan.
