### Consider Approval of the OahuMPO Planning Process Review Implementation Plan

For FY 2012, the OahuMPO Policy Committee approved the budgeting of funds for the OahuMPO Planning Process Review, which was intended to evaluate and improve (where necessary) the 3-C planning process on Oahu. In FY 2014, the scope of the study was changed somewhat to directly address OahuMPO's Federal corrective actions. The consultant, Tindale-Oliver, recently completed the review and evaluation, including a strategic implementation plan to serve as a roadmap to the future.

The OahuMPO Policy Board Bylaws state:

*"The OahuMPO is the forum for cooperative decision-making by local elected officials, operators of public transportation, and decision-makers of general purpose local governments. The specific duties to meet the requirements of the laws include that the Policy Board shall:*

...

*5. Give guidance to the multimodal 3-C Planning Process, and have the overall responsibility for review and approval of all plans and programs which are developed by the process." (Emphasis added)*

Therefore, OahuMPO staff is bringing to you the Planning Process Review and Implementation Plan for your consideration. Approval of the document will allow OahuMPO staff to begin addressing the recommended actions contained in the implementation plan (see attached).
