To that end, the Issues Investigation Committee (IIC) was tasked with working collaboratively with stakeholders in the development of a tool that will assist the CAC in their evaluations within the context of a Complete Streets framework. This evaluation tool will further public awareness of the agency's efforts to reasonably accommodate access and mobility for all users of public facilities funded by federal dollars.
